The Bank Identifier Code (BIC), also known as the SWIFT Address, is the code necessary to send automated International Payments quickly and accurately to the banks concerned.

What is a Sort Code?

Sort Code is an international bank code.

What is an IBAN number?

IBAN (International Bank Account Number) is the international standard for identifying international bank accounts across national borders.

The IBAN is comprised of maximum of 27 alphanumeric characters within Europe and maximum of 34 outside of Europe. At present the United States does not participate in IBAN.
